

BUILDING MAINTENANCE/REPAIR

Since the last Annual Report, the following repair/maintenance items have been accomplished:

- 1) Painting of main entrance to Church sanctuary, including doors, pillars, overhang, facade and base of steeple;
- 2) Carpentry repair of window sills and frames of windows around main entrance to Church sanctuary;
- 4) Old kitchen in basement converted into preschool classroom;
- 5) New circulating pump installed for Church heating system;
- 6) New AC condenser units and system installed in Beinecke Building;
- 7) Refrigerator/freezer unit in kitchen replaced more size appropriate/economical unit;
- 8) Continuing annual program of power washing Columbarium and other accessible areas of Church Building and Beinecke Building and will touch up paint trim where needed.
